Ritual _____

Members offer advice to the Rabbi on the character of religious services, recommend policy involving Jewish ritual practice, including Bar and Bat Mitzvahs and assist in evaluating rabbinical and cantorial candidates. Also handle logistics for High Holidays services.

Education _____

Members act as a “Board of Education” for the JCK School, determining its policies and recommending staff for employment. They sponsor special events for the school’s children, like the Hanukkah party and Purim carnival.

Membership _____

Members act as the Congregation’s “marketers.” They speak to prospective members, organize efforts to recruit new members, and conduct activities to integrate new members into the congregation family.

Finance _____

Members work with the Treasurer on financial matters like policies for dues relief and dues collection, preparation of the annual proposed budget, and strategies for increasing supermarket voucher sales to congregants.

Community Outreach _____

Members organize committee and congregational efforts to help the needy in our community. Their many projects include collecting food for local food pantries, and helping in an inter-faith effort with the homeless. The committee may also organize visits to shut-ins, orphanages and/or nursing homes.

Adult Education _____

Members run frequent brunches with guest lecturers on a variety of Jewish subjects. They also plan relevant field trips.

Social _____

Members organize events to foster fun and fellowship of congregants. Social events may include parties with Jewish music, Israeli dancing, Klezmer concerts, film study nights, or holiday themed dinners.

Fundraising _____

Members run activities to raise money for the congregation’s general operating fund. Examples of these activities are progressive dinners, wine tasting, 3-on-3 basketball tournament and raffles.

Publicity _____

Members send out press releases and attempt to get coverage of JCK events to make the community aware of the congregation and to promote membership. They also oversee the Newsletter.

Building _____

Members meet with CBS members to review and approve expenses need to maintain our premises.

Oneg _____

Members arrange with Oneg sponsors for refreshments after services.

Interfaith Outreach _____

Members run programs to address concerns of interfaith couples and help them feel welcome at the JCK.
